ABOUT TRIP

Join Dr. LaSalle and CoPastor Portia Brooks Vaughn along with the New Life Christian Center family for Israel 2023—the Milk and Honey Tour. After all that has transpired in the world since our last trip to Israel in March 2018, we are set to return to the Promise Land. This tour will focus on reconnecting with the people and the land of Israel. We will visit ancient ruins and historic sites where Jesus, along with His Disciples, the prophets, and great Biblical leaders, lived and walked. We will experience the culture, the food, shopping, and most importantly, the spiritual connection of being able to see the places in the Bible in person. We believe this will be a trip that will rejuvenate and recalibrate your spiritual relationship with the Lord! We hope to see you on our trip!

### **Our 12-day trip will include:**

- Roundtrip coach class airfare between San Antonio/Austin and Tel Aviv
- Lodging in luxury hotels including the Carlton Tel Aviv, Leonardo Plaza Tiberias, Israel Dead Sea, and David Citadel in Jerusalem
- Breakfast and dinner daily while in Israel
- Guided tours in luxury coaches

### **General Itinerary (subject to change)**

**Day 1:** Depart San Antonio/Austin for Tel Aviv.

**Day 2:** Arrive in Tel Aviv and transfer to the hotel. Enjoy the evening exploring Tel Aviv on your own. (Dinner)

**Day 3:** Enjoy the cosmopolitan and culturally diverse city of Tel Aviv. You will have time to explore this city on your own. (Breakfast/Dinner)

**Day 4:** We will tour areas around Tel Aviv and see historical and significant sites and places in the history of Israel. (Breakfast/Dinner)

**Day 5:** Travel to Tiberias, a city on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. Along the way, we will visit Caesarea by the Sea, Mt. Carmel, where Elijah was victorious over the prophets of Baal, and Haifa, a major city on the Mediterranean Coast. (Breakfast/Dinner)

**Day 6:** We will start our day by taking a private boat ride across the Sea of Galilee. During our boat ride, we will have a time of worship on the water and get a special teaching from Pastor Vaughn. Afterward, we will explore the Galilee region and visit places such as the Genosar Boat Museum, the Mt of Beatitudes, Capernaum, and Peter's house. (Breakfast/Dinner)

**Day 7:** We will travel to Safed (or Tzefat), home of Kabbalah (Jewish mysticism), where we will tour the ancient synagogue and artist quarters. You will have time to shop at some galleries and other shops. We will go to the traditional baptismal site, where you will have the opportunity to be baptized in the Jordan River by Pastor Vaughn as a renewal of your faith. Those baptized will receive a baptism certificate. Afterward, we will travel to the Dead Sea area overnight. (Breakfast/Dinner)

**Day 8:** Enjoy the day relaxing in a spa or wade in the Dead Sea. We will return to our hotel in the Dead Sea. (Breakfast/Dinner)

**Day 9:** We will visit Masada, where you can take the cable car to the top (or if adventurous and physically fit, you can walk up the steps) to visit the restored Roman palaces, bath houses, and Jewish synagogue. We will leave Masada and travel to Jerusalem, the City of David. After dinner, you will be on your own to explore the surrounding area. (Breakfast/Dinner)

**Day 10:** We will visit sites such as the Mount of Olives, Garden of Gethsemane, the Old City, St. Anne's Church, Via Dolorosa, and Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial. (Breakfast/Dinner)

**Day 11:** We will continue our tour of Jerusalem, visiting other sites, including David's tomb, Room of the Last Supper, and the Jewish Quarter on our way to the Rabbinical Tunnels and the Western Wall, where you will have time to pray. Our last stop of the day will be the Garden Tomb, considered by many to be the place of Jesus' burial and resurrection. We will take communion and then return to the hotel for dinner and late-night checkout for our flight back to the US. (Breakfast/Dinner)

**Day 12:** We depart Israel early morning and arrive in San Antonio/Austin, TX late afternoon.

New Life Christian Center is an arranger of the travel. The terms "we", "us", "our", and "NLCC" refer to New Life Christian Center, New Life Christian Ministry, Inc, its ministries, divisions, consultants, and/or affiliates. The term "you" "traveler" refers to the traveler making a booking with us and all members of their group.

### I. Contract

These Terms and Conditions of travel, including all brochures, documents, correspondence and the terms and conditions of our suppliers form the basis of the contract with you. Before making a booking with us you must ensure that you have read and understood these Terms and Conditions (raising any questions you may have with us). **Please be aware that these Terms and Conditions contain waivers of liability as well as waiver of class action and venue selection and notice clauses.** By paying a deposit and asking us to confirm your booking you are accepting all of the Terms and Conditions laid out below and acknowledging that you have read the Terms of this contract and agree with them. If you are making a booking as a group, the leader of the group is responsible for sharing these Terms and Conditions with all members of the group and is financially responsible for the booking. We will not be liable for a group leader's failure to share these Terms with all travelers in their group. You represent and warrant that (a) you are of sufficient age to use our services and website and can create binding legal obligations in connection with your use, (b) you are legally authorized to act on behalf of those you represent and accept these Terms and Conditions on their behalf, and (c) the information supplied by you or members of your group is true and correct. **VIOLATIONS BY YOU.** You agree that any violation of any such terms and conditions may result in (a) the cancellation of your reservation or purchase, (b) your forfeiture of any monies paid for your reservation or purchase, and (c) you being denied access to the applicable travel related product or service. **CHANGES TO THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS.** NLCC reserves the right, in our sole discretion, to change these Terms and Conditions at any time. Updated versions of the terms and conditions will be posted here on this website and are effective immediately on posting. If we make material changes, we will notify you. Please check frequently, especially before you make a booking, to see if these Terms and Conditions changed. Your continued use of our services including continuing to use or maintain any bookings after any changes to the Terms and Conditions constitutes your consent to the changes.

### II. COVID 19 Release of Liability

By booking a tour at this time, you acknowledge the highly contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk for yourself and any minors traveling with you, that you or they may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by traveling and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death even if such injuries or losses occur in a manner that is not foreseeable at the time you book your tour. You acknowledge that exposure to such viruses or disease is an inherent risk of traveling, that cannot be controlled or eliminated by NLCC. You acknowledge that due to the uncertainty of travel at this time, your tour may be postponed or cancelled, or changes may be made to itineraries due to closures of certain sites or activities, for which there may be no refund. You may also be required to quarantine upon arrival in some locations. Some locations may require you to have a vaccination or proof of negative testing. You are responsible for understanding these requirements and must not rely on NLCC to provide these details. You understand that you may become sick before, during, or after the tour and may not be able to travel and such cancellation or interruption will be subject to our cancellation terms below, for which we will not be liable. **NLCC highly encourages the purchase of travel protection coverage including cancel for any reason coverage if and when available, and that should you fail to purchase travel protection coverage, NLCC shall not be liable to any losses howsoever arising.**

You, for yourself, and any minors traveling with you, and on behalf of your and their heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin (The Releasees), HEREBY RELEASE, AND HOLD HARMLESS NLCC, its members, officers, agents, and/or employees, suppliers, and other tour members (RELEASEES), of from and against any and all claims, damages, demands, losses, and liability arising out of or related in any way, in whole or in part to any POSTPONEMENT, CANCELLATION, CHANGES, INJURY, DISABILITY, DEATH OR ANY OTHER LOSS you may suffer due to exposure, infection, spread, closure, and travel restrictions related to COVID- 19, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, to the fullest extent permitted by law. The terms of this HOLD HARMLESS AND RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY paragraph, shall survive any termination or cancellation of this Contract, whether by operation of law or otherwise.

### III. Pricing

To secure a reservation you must pay the required non-refundable deposit. The tour price is based on two individuals (age 12 and above) sharing per room unless the single person or child price is paid. Tour price is based on a minimum of 40 travelers and includes round trip coach airfare to and from Israel (per the itinerary); ground transportation, lodging, and meals as per the itinerary. Any items not specifically listed on the itinerary are not included. If due to circumstances beyond the control of New Life Christian Center (NLCC) and/or our travel providers/suppliers, airlines, or operators increase the price, NLCC will adjust the price accordingly. Should a single traveler wish to share a room with another traveler, and NLCC is unable to match him/her with a roommate, the single room price may apply. Should the number of participants, 60 days prior to departure, be lower than the minimum number of participants to operate the trip, the price may be adjusted accordingly. You must make all payments in full and on time. If full payment is not received by the payment deadline, we reserve the right to cancel your travel and apply the cancellation charges set out in the cancellation section below. Failure to make a payment may result in the cancellation of your travel. In such a case this would be considered a cancellation by you and the cancellation terms and fees as described below would be in effect. We reserve the right to refuse any booking in which case a full refund will be provided.

### IV. Payments

While we do accept major credit cards including Visa, Mastercard, American Express and Discover, travelers must provide to us a click or signed authorization for every transaction for your trip. Your authorization is an agreement for us to charge your card and an acknowledgement and agreement to these terms and conditions including the cancellation terms. As such you agree not to make any improper chargebacks. In certain cases, you have the ability to dispute charges with credit card companies ("chargebacks"). Before initiating a chargeback, we ask you first to call us to discuss any questions or concerns about our charges. We will work with you in attempting to resolve your concerns. By using our service to make a reservation, you accept and agree to our cancellation policy. NLCC retains the right to dispute any chargeback that is improper and recover any costs, including attorney's fees related to improper chargebacks. Additionally, in the event of an improper chargeback, we retain the right to cancel any travel reservation related to that improper chargeback. The following chargeback scenarios are improper, and we retain the right to investigate and rebut any such chargeback claims: 1) Chargebacks resulting from non-cancellable reservations, whether or not the reservation is used. 2) Chargebacks resulting from charges authorized by family, friends, associates or other third parties with direct access to your credit card. This does not include credit card fraud. 3) Chargebacks arising from inconsistency or inaccuracy with regard to the supplier's product description. 4) Chargebacks resulting from force majeure or other circumstances that are beyond the control of NLCC or the Supplier. 5) Chargebacks resulting because you do not agree with the cancellation policy.

### V. Cancellation and Refunds:

The following cancellation schedule applies to this tour: 1) **All deposits are non-refundable. A deposit may be transferred between travelers in the same, immediate family only.** 2) **For cancellation up to 150 days before the departure date of June 5, 2023, traveler will be refunded 95% of the amount paid after deducting the deposit.** 3) **For cancellation between 149 days to 60 days before the departure date, a cancellation fee of 50% of the tour cost will apply.** 4) **For cancellation 59 days or less before to the departure date, NO REFUND.**

Travelers are strongly encouraged to purchase travel protection insurance. There is no refund for unused arrangements. We will inform you as soon as reasonably possible if we need to make a significant change to the tour. We reserve the right to cancel or reschedule any departure for any reason. If we cancel, except in the case of a force majeure event, we will offer alternate arrangements. We may at our sole discretion offer refunds in accordance with the cancellation schedule above. Traveler is responsible for any additional costs for air tickets or other travel arrangements not made by us.

### VI. Force Majeure

NLCC assumes no liability for, any loss, damage, delay, or cancellation resulting in whole or in part from an Act of God or any other Force Majeure condition, including, without limitation: fire, volcanic eruption, hurricane, environmental pollution or contamination, inclement weather, earthquake, low or high water levels, flood, water or power shortages or failures, tropical storms or hurricanes, riots or civil commissions or disturbances, and any other acts of a similar nature, sabotage, arrests, strikes or labor disruptions, restraint of rulers or peoples, expropriations, acts of terrorism, war, insurrection, quarantine restrictions, government health advisories, epidemics, pandemics, or warnings or alerts of any kind of nature, government seizures, refusal or cancellation or suspension or delay of any government authority or any license, permit or authorization, damages to its facilities or the travel supplier and its facilities, or any other unforeseen circumstances or any other factors outside of the control of NLCC that impacts negatively on, or hampers, our or our suppliers' ability to fulfill any of its contractual conditions. In the circumstances amounting to Force Majeure, we will not be required to refund any money to you.

### VII. Responsibility and Liability

By signing the registration form or making any payments towards the tour, Traveler (or person paying for the trip) acknowledges that the NLCC (defined as and including its officers, directors, employees, and/or official representatives; divisions, subsidiaries, Ministries; affiliates, travel consultants, or agents (hereafter collectively referred to as NLCC)) is acting solely as the arranger for this tour in all matters pertaining to hotel accommodations, airlines, ground transportation, ship lines, restaurants, etc., and as such, is not liable in the event of any failure by any person or company to render services to be provided on the tour or for any loss, injury, or damage to any tour traveler or their belongings, or otherwise, in connection with any service supplied or not supplied resulting directly or indirectly from any occurrence beyond the control of NLCC. NLCC is not liable or responsible for any accident, loss, delay, omission, injury or illness, nonperformance, and/or damage(s) resulting from acts of God; acts of governments or other authorities; wars declared or undeclared, acts of terrorism; weather or climatic events; civil disturbances, strikes, riots, thefts, or pilferage; sickness, epidemics/pandemics, quarantines, medical or customs regulations; defaults, delays, cancellation of or changes in itinerary, or for any other loss or damage resulting from improper or insufficient passport, visas or other documents; and/or legal or criminal proceedings involving the Traveler, associated with this tour. Traveler shall indemnify and hold harmless NLCC for any and all claims and liabilities as stated in these Terms & Conditions. Traveler's deposit payment or any other payment towards this trip on behalf of Traveler shall constitute full acknowledgement and acceptance of all terms and conditions for this tour and that NLCC is engaging arrangements on his/her behalf. Traveler agrees that restitution for damages, if any are claimed, shall be sought directly from the operators (hotels, airlines, ship lines, bus companies, restaurants) and not NLCC (as defined herein). The Passenger contract in use by the airline concerned, when issued, shall constitute the sole contract between the airline and the purchaser and/or passenger of the ticket.

### VIII. Assumption of Risk

Traveler is aware that travel such area as traveler is undertaking on the trip may involve inherent risks, some in remote areas of the world. Inherent risks include, but are not limited to, risk of injury or death from: motor vehicles collisions, roadway hazards, slips, and falls, including falls due to uneven pavement, conditions on hiking trails, criminal or terrorist acts, government actions, consumption of alcoholic beverages, tainted food, or non-potable water; exposure to the elements, including heat, cold, sun, water, and wind; your own negligence and/or the negligence of others, including tour guides, other travelers, NLCC and its employees, agents and/or representatives; attack by or encounter with insects, reptiles, and/or animals; accidents or illness occurring in remote places where there are no available medical services; fatigue, chill, overheating, and/or dizziness; known or unknown medical conditions, physical excursion for which you are not prepared or other such accidents; the negligence or lack of adequate training of any third-party providers who seek to assist with medical or other help either before or after injuries have occurred; accident or illness without access to means of rapid evacuation or availability of medical supplies or services; and the adequacy of medical attention once provided. Traveler understands the description of these risks, is not complete and that unknown or unanticipated risks may result in injury, illness, or death. In order to partake of the enjoyment and excitement of this trip, traveler is willing to accept the risks and uncertainty involved as being an integral part of travel, including the risk of infection, illness and death. Traveler hereby accepts and assumes full responsibility for any and all risks and agrees to and shall hold harmless and fully release NLCC from any and all claims associated with the trip, including any claims of third-party negligence and/or the negligence of NLCC and traveler hereby covenant not to sue NLCC for any such claims or join any lawsuit or action that is suing NLCC. This agreement also binds your heirs, legal representatives and assigns. The terms of this HOLD HARMLESS AND RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY paragraph, shall survive any termination or cancellation of this Contract, whether by operation of law or otherwise.

### IX. Indemnification and Behavior

Each traveler is expected to act responsibly and adhere to all behavior guidelines established by NLCC and our local suppliers. We and our local suppliers reserve the right to remove you from any trip if your behavior in our sole discretion interferes with the enjoyment of the trip or you endanger yourself or others. In any such case, there will be no refund and NLCC will not be responsible for any additional costs you incur as a result of removal. Traveler agrees to and shall indemnify and hold harmless NLCC, and each of our officers, directors, employees and agents (collectively "NLCC"), from any expenses, losses, liabilities, damages, judgments, settlements and costs (collectively, "damages") involved with or incurred by NLCC (including, without limitation, reasonable attorneys' fees and the advancement of same) with respect to any claims, law suits, arbitrations, or other causes of action, which result, directly or indirectly, from: (i) traveler's breach or violation, or threatened breach or violation, of this Agreement and (ii) Any damage caused by traveler while participating in the trip.

### X. Optional Activities

If we suggest alternate activities or you encounter the opportunity to participate in additional, optional activities that are provided by independent third-party suppliers, you will be subject to the terms and conditions of that supplier. The supplier may require you to execute additional documents, waivers, or releases. In any case, your only recourse in case of damage will be against the supplier of the alternate activity.

### XI. Insurance

It is the traveler's responsibility to protect their purchases. For this reason, Travel Protection Coverage including additional cancel for any reason coverage is strongly recommended. NLCC recommends Traveler purchase commercially available travel insurance including additional cancel for any reason coverage. Traveler is solely responsible for determining the appropriate coverage and carrier for their requirements. NLCC recommends Traveler include accidental death and disability, medical (e.g., injury or sickness, including pandemic related sickness during travel) emergency medical evacuation, loss of personal effects, trip interruption, and trip cancellation coverage. This insurance should typically be purchased within 7 days of paying your deposit (or full payment if Traveler did not elect deposit payment option) to get certain coverage such as pre-existing conditions or cancel for any reason. NLCC does not endorse any specific insurance carrier/provider, cannot answer technical questions about the benefits, exclusions, and conditions of travel insurance plans, and cannot evaluate the adequacy of the prospective insured's existing insurance coverage. If you have any questions about your travel protection, call your insurer or insurance provider, agent or broker. Certain countries have a requirement for foreign visitors to have valid medical insurance on entry. NLCC cannot be held responsible for denied entry if a traveler is unable to provide details to authorities of insurance or denial of entry for any reason. Declining to purchase an adequate travel protection plan could result in the loss of your travel cost and/or require more money to correct the situation. You also acknowledge that without this coverage, there may be no way to recoup any losses, costs or expenses incurred. **If you choose to travel without adequate coverage, we will not be liable for any of your losses howsoever arising, for which trip protection plan coverage would otherwise have been available.**

### XII. Alterations

NLCC reserves the right to change the itinerary, and suppliers as deemed necessary, to include but not be limited to, unforeseen circumstances; airline, ship, or ground transportation changes; security matters; Government imposed bans/restrictions; site accessibility; and/or events beyond NLCC control that make such alterations necessary. In all cases, NLCC will strive to maintain the quality of the tour. Should the US government or Israel national government impose regulations or restrictions preventing the tour from taking place as originally scheduled, NLCC will evaluate the circumstances and available options and take the course of action most appropriate for the Tour. NLCC cannot be held responsible for any closures, necessary itinerary changes, or curtailments for any reason. These changes will not be considered material changes and will not be considered cause for cancellation by the traveler. Normal cancellation penalties still apply to the tour that has been changed.

### XIII. Severability

This is the entire agreement of the parties, and it may be amended only in writing by NLCC. If any part of this agreement is held unenforceable by a court of law in the State of Texas, the rest of this agreement shall remain in force and effect.

### XIV. EXCLUSIONS: Our tour DOES NOT include:

Fees for obtaining passports or visas, excess baggage charges, tours or activities not specifically listed in the itinerary; vaccinations/inoculations; travel, accident or baggage insurance; lunches; airport departure taxes not included in ticket price; airline surcharges (e.g. fuel surcharge, etc.), local tours; government taxes/tariffs; customs duties; any items of a personal nature, such as phone calls, laundry, photographs, faxes, internet, spa treatments, gym, room service, etc.; tips for bus driver, tour guides, and hotel staff; spa treatments, gym usage, medical testing, or any other service not specifically listed in Paragraph I. Pricing, in this Terms & Conditions. This is an illustrative list and not a complete list of all items not included.

### XV. Destinations and Passport and VISA Requirements

Travel to certain destinations may involve greater risk than others. NLCC urges Travelers to remain informed on a daily basis as to current news, as well as to review travel prohibitions, warnings, announcements and advisories issued by the United States Government prior to booking travel to international destinations. Information on conditions in various countries and the level of risk associated with travel to particular international destinations can be found at <http://www.state.gov>, and <http://www.cdc.gov>. In addition, you should consult with government websites to ensure that you are in compliance with all requirements for admittance into that country, including COVID-19 requirements, as well as understanding local laws that govern travel within a country, such as medical tests and tracking. It is your responsibility to be aware of any and all requirements for admittance to a country or state, including Covid-19 requirements. Should you choose to travel to a country that has been issued a travel warning or advisory, NLCC will not be liable for damages or losses that result from travel to such destinations. **This trip is offered only to US passport holders.** It is the responsibility of each traveler to obtain and carry a valid passport, visa(s), inoculations, and all other documents required by applicable government regulations. For up-to-date requirements US citizens should visit [www.travel.state.gov](http://www.travel.state.gov). US passports must: 1) Have an expiration date six months or longer beyond the trip end date and 2) Must have two (2) blank sided VISA pages. Currently, Israel does not charge a fee for the tourist visa that covers this trip. However, should a visa fee be instituted, Traveler shall be responsible for such fee(s). Names provided to secure reservations must match travelers' passport. Date of birth and complete passport details are required. Any minor name corrections advised after airline tickets have been issued will incur fees. Not all name corrections will be permitted by airlines and may require the purchase of a new ticket. Travelers voluntarily assume full and sole responsibility for any and all risks and/or costs involved with failure to report any errors and/or omissions to documentation.

### XVI. Health Matters

The Traveler acknowledges that they are in satisfactory medical condition to participate on this trip and voluntarily assumes all risks. Traveler should ensure they are current with any required vaccinations and should consult with their health care provider if in doubt. Traveler should consult with their insurance providers to determine if they have medical coverage for international locations or obtain appropriate travel insurance that includes medical coverage that is commercially available. **Traveler shall be responsible for ensuring they obtain any required Covid-19 virus test or vaccination(s) prior to their trip and testing negative within the required timeframe published by the destination country and/or by the airline. NLCC is not responsible for denial of travel or entry by airline and/or Government agencies.** Recommended inoculations for travel may change and you should consult your practitioner for current recommendations before you depart. It is your responsibility to ensure that you meet all health entry requirements, obtain the recommended inoculations, take all recommended medication, and follow all medical advice in relation to your trip. ### XVII. Pre-Existing Conditions/Persons with Disabilities

The nature of many of the destinations we travel to means that in some cases they may be unsuitable for those who use a wheelchair or have a lack of mobility. NLCC will communicate requests to Suppliers but cannot be responsible if ADA accommodations are not available. Any accommodations provided will be at the sole expense of the traveler requiring the accommodation. **Please note that accommodations outside of the USA may not be in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act and may not have wheelchair accessibility.** NLCC and our Suppliers are, unfortunately, unable to offer additional assistance to travelers with limited mobility and all such assistance will need to be provided by whoever the traveler is traveling with. Travelers with disabilities must notify NLCC at the time of booking of status and of the identity of their non-discounted, paid travel companion who will be responsible for providing all necessary assistance. We may request that you provide a letter from your doctor confirming your fitness to travel. For the safety of our guests, NLCC reserves the right to request health information prior to travel and to exclude any participants it deems unfit for travel at its sole discretion.

### XVIII. Governing Law/Jurisdiction/Limitation of Damages/Class Action Waiver/Notice

This Agreement and all attachments hereto and the rights of the parties hereunder shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas exclusive of conflict or choice of law rules. Any claims shall be brought in a court of competent jurisdiction located in Texas. You agree that you will only bring claims against NLCC in your individual capacity and not as a plaintiff or class member in and purported class action or representative proceeding. NLCC shall not in any case be liable for other than compensatory damages, and your payment of a deposit on a trip means that you agree to these conditions of sale and expressly waive any right to punitive damages. **You understand and agree that no claims will be considered and that you will not bring suit against NLCC unless you have first provided a typewritten notice of claim to NLCC within 30 days after the tour or cancellation of the trip.**
